The manner in which the results will be determined and prizes awarded	Shotgun Shootout will be 2 entrants competing side by side on identical tests. Tests are to be in accordance with standard Motorkhana Handbook guidelines. Start at drop of flag, first to complete the course without penalty awarded a "win". Wins will be tallied after equal number of tests by each entrant to determine seeding for a set of knockout tests. Entrants then compete to knock each other out with final entrant declared the winner. Prizes to be awarded to Winner and Runner-up at the conclusion of Shootouts (approx. 17:30pm) Motorkhana will be timed using electronic beam timing system. 2 runs per test set with best time from the 2 runs counting towards total. Minimum of 4 tests to be set. Prizes to be awarded to Winner and Runner-up at conclusion of event (approx. 22:15pm)
Shotgun Shootout – to be eligible for the knockout phase an entrant must complete least 75% of the preliminary "seeding" rounds. All entrants will be allocated a passenger to accompany them during the test. This applies to all tests attempted during the entire event.	

CLASSES:

As per Impreza WRX Club 2023 SubiNats schedule – only Subaru vehicles may be entered for competition. There is no distinction between Subaru variants, all compete in the same class.

 - Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed/consented to by a parent/guardian
 - The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.
 - Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

Integrity, Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances
